Vermilda Albina Wyzkiewicz, 93, of Hampton Twp., affectionately known as “Millie” to many, our loving, caring, hardworking, loyal and gentle wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother was born into eternal life on Saturday, December 26, 2020 at New Hope Bay.

Vermilda was born on June 16, 1927 in Hampton Twp., the daughter of the late Frank and Clara (Pero) Badour. Vermilda attended Hugo School. While she was working on the farm, she happened to meet a young prankster by the name of Edward J. Wyzkiewicz.
